## BIBLE PERESCOPIES

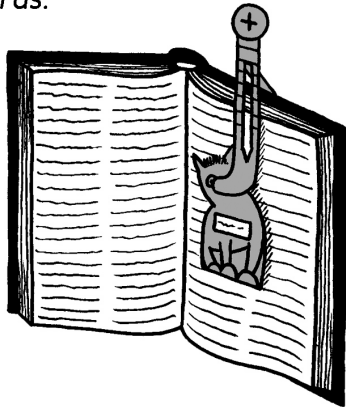
## ACTIVITY PAGE

Here is a game to play with a friend that has the same Bible as you and a Bible perescope of their own.

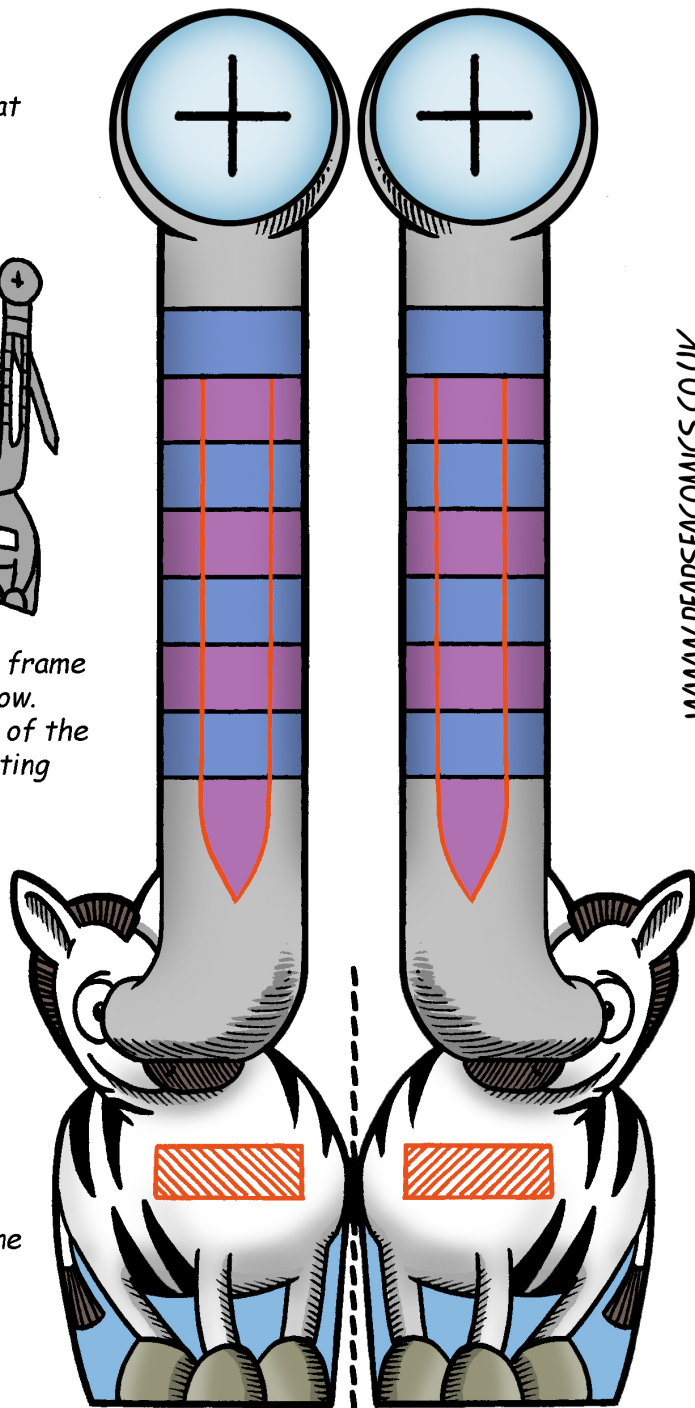
Cut out this Bible perescope. Fold along the dotted line and glue the two sides together. Cut out the red window and along the red line to make an arrow that folds out. For this use a craft knife (with the help of an adult if need be).



Find a friend with the same Bible as you and open them at the same page. Sit face to face so each of you can only see the cover of the other's Bible. Take your perescope and frame some words on the page using the window. The arrow should be bent over the top of the Bible so that it rests on the cover pointing downwards.



Your friend must now locate at least one word in your window by judging the position of your perescope and placing his in his Bible. If you find it too easy decide on one word only positioned in a corner of the window.
